1. INTRODUCTION

The Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza Inc. is an enthusiastic committee committed to providing beef enthusiasts with competition and education in the Australian Beef Industry. In order to facilitate this mission an exciting new project has been formulated which enables beef enthusiasts and established producers to showcase their cattle, learn more about the beef industry and network with other producers. The 2010 event was an outstanding success with excellent entries including 250 prime cattle 24 heifers and around 400 paraders and junior judges. In excess of \$7,000.00 in cash prize money was given away at the 2010 event.

The Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza consists of open led cattle classes and carcass competition, open unled prime classes and carcass competition, interactive unled judging display, junior meat judging competition and junior judging and parader's competitions.

2. CHANGES TO THE PROGRAM FOR 2011

- **Primary Paraders will be judged Saturday afternoon following the Stud Heifer classes.**
- **Delivery slip for unled exhibits (in exhibitors pack) must be left in the agent's box at Scone saleyards upon delivery of all unled cattle.**

3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR PRIME LIVE CLASSES & CARCASS CLASSES

- Led and unled classes are open to all exhibitors with steers and heifers both eligible to compete.
- All exhibits entered for this section are required to be judged as carcasses and will thus be slaughtered.
- All exhibits must be milk teeth. Any exhibit that shows evidence of adult teeth will not be eligible to compete.
- All exhibits must not have been treated with hormone growth promotants and not be within a withholding period or ESI at the time of slaughter.
- All exhibits must carry an NLIS device and be accompanied by a completed NVD form at the time of arrival.
- All exhibits must have a quiet temperament. Exhibits deemed as being dangerous will be disqualified at the discretion of the Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza Committee.
- There will be a limit to the number of led (approx 180) entries that can be accepted. Entries will be accepted on a first in basis.
- Carcasses will be judged in their respective live classes against the nominated specifications regardless of their final carcass weight.
- Exhibits nominated as purebreds will be inspected for breed purity. Any exhibit that does not comply with its breed's standard of excellence will not be eligible to compete for purebred prizes. The eligibility will be determined by the Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza Committee. Scurs and horns on polled breeds will not be accepted.

- Exhibits must be polled or dehorned. Dehorned exhibits must not possess more than 3cm of horn.
- Carcase prizes will be determined by the respective points each carcase scores. Pen of Three classes will be determined by the pen's total aggregate score.
- All led exhibits are to have a nose grip or nose ring attached when not tied up. When tied up all led exhibits must be secured by a halter and neck strap.
- **Champion Led Exhibit will be transported to the Scone Saleyards to compete for Supreme Champion Exhibit.**
- Classes will be split according to entry numbers. However, the committee reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of classes dependent on entries received.
- Unled entries will be accepted as individuals or pens of three.
- To be eligible for the pen of three unled section, all exhibits must be within a 50kg weight range of the respective class.
- **Please note at the judge's discretion, an animal may be eligible to compete for Champion Unled animal and Supreme Champion animal.**
- Pen of Three carcasses will be assessed according to their individual live weight division. i.e. it is possible to have carcasses within a Pen of Three that are assessed on two different carcase specifications but are within the required 50kg live weight spread.

3.1 Led Prime Classes

- Lightweight Steer/Heifer (300kg - 400kg liveweight)
 - 1-15 hd (1 class) 16-30 hd (2 classes) 30+ (3 classes)
- Middleweight Steer/Heifer (401kg - 500kg liveweight)
 - 1-15 hd (1 class) 16-30 hd (2 classes) 30+ (3 classes)
 - If greater than 50 entries are received the middleweight section will be divided into light- middleweight and heavy-middleweight champion divisions.
- Heavyweight Steer/Heifer (501+ kg liveweight)
 - 1-15 hd (1 class) 16-30 hd (2 classes) 30+ (3 classes)

3.2 Unled Individual Classes

- Lightweight Steer/Heifer (300kg - 400kg liveweight)
- Middleweight Steer/Heifer (401kg - 500kg liveweight)
- Heavyweight Steer/Heifer (501kg + liveweight)

3.3 Unled Pens of Three Class

- Pen of Three Steers/Heifers within a 50kg weight range (minimum weight of any individual within a team is 300kg liveweight.)
- **Please note at the judge's discretion, an animal may be pulled out of a pen of three to compete for Champion Unled animal and Supreme Champion animal.**

4. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR STUD HEIFER CLASSES

- Heifers must be registered with their relevant breed society. A copy of their certificate is to accompany entry. The classes will be conducted as interbreed classes.
- Heifers must be between 8 months and 20 months as of the 29th October, 2011.
- Heifers must be weaned prior to the show. There are no facilities available for mature cows.
- Heifers must not have had a calf.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for meeting their reporting obligations related to the NLIS database. The White Park PIC for transfers is NA521895.**

4.1 Stud Heifer Classes

- 8mths - <12 months (birthdates from 29th October 2010 to 1st March, 2011)
- 12 mths - <`16mths (birthdates from 29th June, 2010 to 28th October 2010.)
- 16mths - < 20mths (birthdates from 1st March, 2010 to 28th June 2010.)

5. JUNIOR JUDGING

- Junior Judging classes will take place on Sunday morning. They are open to all competitors under 25yrs. The entry fee for Junior Judging and paraders is \$5 inclusive of both competitions. Entries will be accepted at the administration office at White Park from 12 noon **Friday 28th October until 12noon on Saturday 29th October.**

5.1 Junior Judging Classes

- Primary
- 12 -15 yrs
- 16 -17years
- 18 -24years

6. PARADERS

- Primary Paraders classes will take place on Saturday afternoon following the conclusion of the stud heifer judging.
- Paraders classes will take place on Sunday morning.
- The entry fee for Paraders and Junior Judging is \$5 (inclusive of both competitions). Entries will be accepted at the administration office at White Park from 12 noon **Friday 28th October until 12noon on Saturday 29th October.**
- White dust coats **will not** be required in paraders competitions.
- The paraders competition will be split into three rings.
- Winners from each age group will compete for the champion parader prize.
- Entrants intending to use animals that are not entered in either the prime or stud heifer classes must seek prior approval from the committee as stalling issues arise when unexpected cattle arrive. Stalling fees will apply.

7. CARCASE JACKPOT

A carcass jackpot system will be in operation at the Beef Bonanza. To be eligible for prizes exhibitors must nominate on the entry form and pay the additional \$22 entry fee. Both led and unled exhibits are eligible for inclusion in the Carcass Jackpot competition. Prizemoney for the Jackpot Competition will be determined by the number of entries. All Jackpot entry fees will be allocated to Jackpot prizemoney. The Jackpot prizemoney will be allocated on the following basis. The 2010 jackpot was well supported with excess of \$2300 being in the total jackpot.

- 25% of Jackpot prize pool to best Lightweight Jackpot entered carcass.
- 25% of Jackpot prize pool to best Middleweight Jackpot entered carcass.
- 25% of Jackpot prize pool to best Heavyweight Jackpot entered carcass.
- 25% of Jackpot prize pool to best overall Jackpot entered carcass.

Remember you must be in it to win it!

Please note that Jackpot entries will only be accepted with entry forms. Exhibits can not be nominated for the Carcass Jackpot after the close of entries, i.e. 30th September, 2011.

8. CARCASS SPECIFICATIONS

Carcass classes will be judged using a modified version of the ABCAS. Basic carcass requirements are as follows:

8.1 Lightweight

- P8 fat depth 5-10mm
- Rib fat depth 4-8mm
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a fat colour score above 3
- Deductions will occur for carcasses having a pH above 5.70
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a meat colour score above 3

8.2 Middleweight

- P8 fat depth 8-13mm
- Rib fat depth 4-10mm
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a fat colour score above 3
- Deductions will occur for carcasses having a pH above 5.70
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a meat colour score above 3

8.3 Heavyweight

- P8 fat depth 8-15mm
- Rib fat depth 4-10mm
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a fat colour score above 3
- Deductions will occur for carcasses having a pH above 5.70
- Deductions will apply for carcasses with a meat colour score above 3

9. CARCASS SALES

- The Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza Inc has negotiated a competitive grid payment system for carcasses from the Beef Bonanza. All carcasses will be sold to Primo Australia on the following basis, determined by their carcass weight.

- All carcasses less than 221kg will be sold on a competitive price based on the market for similar liveweight steers at Scone Saleyards the week prior to the Beef Bonanza.
- All Open Carcasses 221kg and heavier will be sold to Primo Australia, on the grid shown below. The base price will be competitive and be available the week prior to the Beef Bonanza.

9.1 Primo Aust Grid for the 2011 Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza

Carcase Weight	P8 Fat Specifications	Price
221 - 260kg	5 - 15mm	Base
261 - 280kg	5 - 15mm	Base - 10cents/kg
281 - 400kg	5 - 15mm	Base - 20cents/kg
Carcasses with 0-4mm or 16-25mm of fat will have a base price -10cents/kg from the 5-15mm grid.		
Please note that heifer and steer base prices may vary.		
Primo will also provide the following incentives for carcasses 1st place +15cents/kg, 2nd place +10cents/kg and 3rd place +5cents/kg.		

- Carcasses that exhibit excessive bruising or a meat colour greater than 3, or a butt score less than C are undesirable and may incur a price discount.
- Carcasses will be sold on carcass weight and in some cases steers from the same class may not be subject to the same grid payment.
- Home kills are not available as a sale option.
- All carcass sales will be conducted by MacCallum Inglis Pty Ltd. MacCallum Inglis are sponsors of the event and will **not be charging commission to facilitate the sales.**

10. WEIGHING

9.1 Led Exhibits-White Park Scone

Steers and heifers for the Prime classes will be weighed between 2.30pm and 4pm on **Friday 28th October 2011**. Exhibits are free to arrive from 7am on Friday 28th October 2011. **All led exhibits must be on the grounds prior to 4pm on Friday 28th October 2011.**

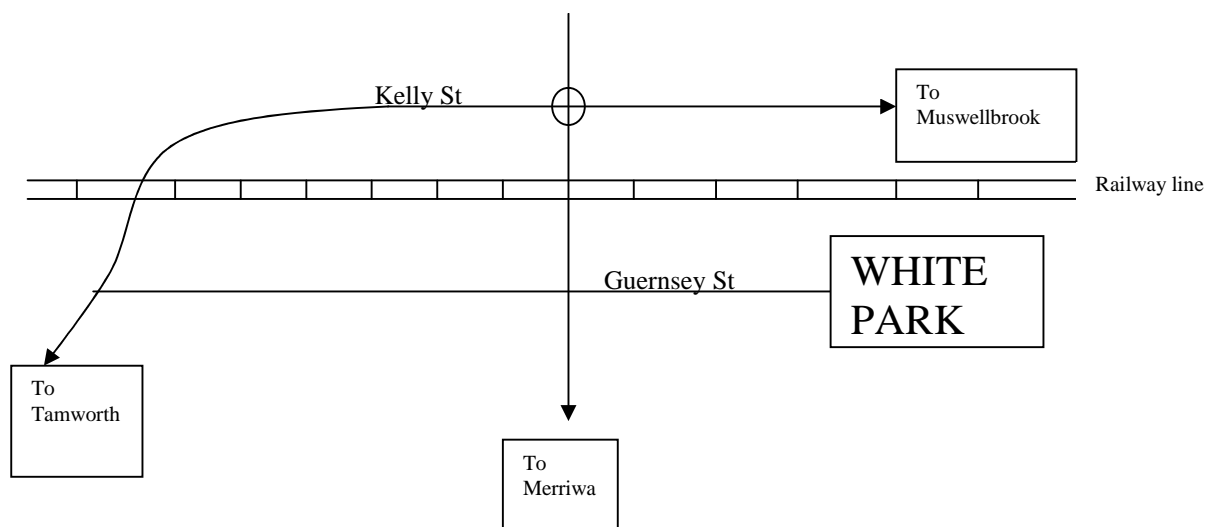
9.2 Unled Exhibits-Scone Saleyards

Steers and heifers for the Prime unled classes will be weighed from 8am on **Saturday 29th October, 2011**. Exhibits are able to arrive at the saleyards on the afternoon of Friday 28th October, 2011. **All unled exhibits must be delivered to Scone Saleyards no later than 8am on Saturday 29th October, 2011.**

- **Delivery slip for unled exhibits (in exhibitors pack) must be left in the agent's box at Scone saleyards upon delivery of all unled cattle.**

12. JUNIOR AUSTRALIAN INTERCOLLEGIATE MEAT JUDGING COMPETITION

The Junior Australian intercollegiate Meat Judging Competition will be held in conjunction with the Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza. 15. INSURANCE & OH&S

- All electrical leads and equipment used during the Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza must be tagged with approved and current safety tags. Please ensure that this requirement is completed.
- All exhibitors must use an individual electrical cut off lead when using electrical equipment.
- Adult supervision is required when electrical equipment is being used by competitors under 18yrs.

15.1 White Park
